THE RULES

ELIGIBILITY

Entrants must be aged between 5-16 on the 28th April 2019. Entrants must not be professional photographers. Only 1 entry per person. Photos cannot have been used in other competitions or publications.

ENTRY PERIOD

The photo contest begins 28th April with last submissions by midnight Sunday 12th May 2019. Entries submitted before or after the entry period will not be eligible. The exhibition will run between late May and June 2019.

WHAT TO ENTER

This spring Highcliffe Castle is experiencing a new beginning with the opening of our East Wing and a whole new exhibition telling the story of both the people and the building. For our 2019 Young People's competition we want to see what 'New Beginnings' means to you: Is it in young animals, people or the tiniest details of spring, in the woods or in your garden? Capture that vibrant moment and express what 'New Beginnings' means to you through photography!

HOW TO ENTER

Please submit files electronically to **kate.barrall@bcpcouncil.gov.uk**. We can only accept digital files for this competition – printed photos cannot be accepted. Make sure your photograph accurately reflects 'New Beginnings' in some way. You must include the entry form.

You must have the permission of your parent or guardian and confirmation that the photograph is your own work.

JUDGING

- Judging will be conducted by a selected committee. Entries will be judged within two specified age groups; Age 5-9 and Age 10-16. The competition winners will be notified by 20th May.
- All judging decisions are final.

AWARD

- First, second and third prize will be awarded for each age group.
- Three highly commended for each age group would also be awarded

EXHIBITION

- The top 3 entries will be shown within an exhibition at the castle between May and June 2019. A selection of other commended entries will also be shown, showcasing the wonderful talent we have in our local area.
