


### Nature Hunting

There are lots of great ways to to hunt for nature. Here are three for you to look for.

Nature Treasure Hunt. What you will need

Paper scissors double-sided sticky tape



#### Get Hunting


Using the attached grid, add a strip of double-sided sticky tape under the name of each item, and remove the second side of tape just before your walk. See if you can find each item and place it on to the sticky tape as you explore.

Remember to only pick leaves and flowers which have fallen to  $\frac{1}{2}$ 

You can also cut out a strip of card and make a nature bracelet: Add a strip of double-sided tape to a cardboard band which fits around your wrist. Secure with normal sticky tape. Add items to your bracelet as you go!

Nature Hunt Square


What you will need

Draw what you can see in this square:










