

Easter Bunny Beetle Drive

A Beetle Drive is a fun traditional British game that anyone can play where you roll a dice and draw a beetle.

Highcliffe Castle has now given this game an Easter makeover so instead of drawing the beetle you draw a bunny!

You will need:

Two or more players Pencil and paper A dice



How to play:

- Everyone takes a turn to roll the dice. You need a 6 to start.
- This allows you to draw the body of the bunny.
- You will need to throw a 5 in order to draw the bunny's head and before you can add in the ears and whiskers.
- If there is more than one part of bunny, you will need to throw that number more than once e.g. for the ears, you will need throw a 3 TWICE to draw both ears.
- First person to draw a complete Easter bunny wins!



What to roll to draw your Easter Bunny

- **6** Body (a bunny has one!)
- **5** Head (you need this before ears and whiskers)
- **4** Whiskers (there are four to draw)
- **3** Ears (all bunnies have two)
- 2 Feet (you only need two)
- **1** Tail (just one fluffy tail to draw)
